Roles and Responsibilities

Direct Engagement, Needs Assessments, and Data Collection

- 1. Conduct rounds in the field and directly engage with individuals and families experiencing unsheltered homelessnes in places not meant for human habitation
- Conduct initial needs assessments and determine eligibility for services by conversation and building relationships to elicit relevant information for the completion of Keela and VI-SPDAT forms
- During rounds, connect with five people experiencing homelessnes and provide information and targeted service referrals including emergency shelters, transitional housing, permanent supportive housing, rapid rehousing, and other community-based services
- 4. Provide intervention services by addressing urgent physical needs
- 5. Offer support for people as they transition from homelessness to housing by providing testimony of experience and empowering their self agency
- 6. Assist clients in the navigation of their homlessness experience by applying motivational interviewing and psychological first aid principles
- 7. Collaborate with Program Manager to create a flexible work schedule that includes regular evening, night and weekend hours
- 8. Assist Outreach Lead in preparation of outreach kits with food, PPE, and other essentials
- Demonstrate a continued commitment to understanding and implementing harm reduction practices and engage in real conversations about safety and the importance of a safety plan
- 10. Effectively communicate orally and via written correspondence by providing all necessary information and follow up to make informed decisions in a timely and accurate manner
- 11. Foster a collaborative work environment and champion accountability
- 12. Other duties as assigned
