SERVE THE COMMUNITY IN RESPONSE TO ROE V WADE BEING OVERTURNED

MADISON, WI (JUNE 24, 2022)—Today the Supreme Court overturned Roe vs. Wade. Roe

vs. Wade was a decision of the U.S Supreme Court in which the court ruled that the Constitution

of the United States generally protects a pregnant woman's liberty to choose to have an abortion.

This news brings Urban Triage and those affected all over the country an unfathomable amount

of sadness, pain, frustration, and uncertainty. We understand how important it is to take action

and provide solutions and resources "For Us, By Us". We stand with women and those who may

become pregnant, and their ability to choose what's right for THEIR BODIES.

As a result of the decision made today, Urban Triage will pivot to meet the needs of the

communities that are most vulnerable. We'll be providing intentional outreach and community

engagement to agencies and institutions that serve vulnerable youth, women, and people within

the LGBTQIA+ community. We'll form partnerships, and provide educational resources and

events, workshops and mental wellness services. We'll also create an asset map and develop a

resource page by way of our website to ensure that people have access to the services and support. In addition, our Supporting Healthy Black Families Youth workgroup curriculum will be expanded to include Reproduction Rights and additional resources to support participants.

We want to remind all who read our statement that the actions today of the Supreme Court are what White Supremacy looks like. It looks like paternalism in which those most impacted by overturning Roe vs. Wade were not involved in the decision nor were they considered; this is what State-sanctioned violence looks like. We're not surprised by the actions of the Supreme Court—this is how white men and white systems show up—too often centering their own agenda(s) and personal needs which disproportionately negatively impact people known as Black. This is a day in history that will live in infamy as a representation of how White Supremacy Patriarchy is active, alive, and well.
